BURSARY APPLICATION

Kermode Friendship Society's bursaries are intended to assist students who are of Indigenous descent and who wish to continue their education at a University, College, Vocational or Technical institute, or other post-secondary institution. Applicant's normal place of residence must be in the Terrace area.

The granting of these bursaries is based on financial need, academic standing and the ability of the student to share with us their passion and motivation to move in their chosen career path. It is of the utmost importance that Kermode Friendship Society ensures that all bursaries are accessible equally to all with fairness and without favoritism.

It should be noted that these bursaries are funded through Kermode Friendship Society's donations received from the general public and therefore may vary from year to year depending on the amount of money available.

All applications are reviewed by an awards committee and are approved or rejected at that level.

ELIGIBILITY:

In order to be eligible for a bursary, a student must be able to meet the following criteria:

- Please complete the Grant Application; & share with the Awards committee, your education, personal goals and the initiative that you've taken to pursue those goals so far.
- Applicants must provide proof of Indigenous ancestry (First Nation, Inuit, and Metis) a photo copy of your status card/metis card are acceptable means of proof we also are able to accept a letter from your band.
- You must have lived in British Columbia for at least 6 months prior to applying for the awards.
- Must maintain a full course work load leading to a recognized degree, diploma, or certificate or Red seal Trade. (3 + courses)
- Provide proof of acceptance into accredited Post Secondary Institution (must be provided before the awards are received).
- Provide proof of registration in a University, College, Vocational institute, or other Post Secondary institution.
- Provide a transcript which shows at least one successful semester in their chosen program (unless he/she is a first-semester student).

FUNDING LIMITS:

Four(4) awards will be distributed as follows:

Grade 12 continuing on to Post Secondary/ Red Seal Trade	\$ 300.00
One College Level Program or 1st or 2 nd level Trades	\$ 500.00
University Level	\$ 600.00
Masters Level University	\$ 600.00

Those applications received will be reviewed by the Board of Directors. Students will be notified of the Boards decision following the review. The payout of approved bursaries will be made during the following month.
